Frequently Asked Questions

When are meetings held?

We meet each and every Monday at 7.00pm for a 7:15pm start and a 8:45pm finish at Rostrata Family Centre, Cnr Prendwick Way & Tilston Close, Prendwick Reserve, Willetton.

I have already been a guest; can I come along again without having to join?

Absolutely! Sometimes it can take a few meetings to know if Toastmasters is for you.

What will I learn from Toastmasters?

You will learn to overcome your fear of public speaking, build your communication and speaking skills plus improve your self-confidence while you grow as a leader.

What do I get as a member?

Along with the opportunity to practice your speaking skills, you will be given workbooks on communication and leadership. These will help you develop a core set of public speaking skills and improve on your speaking and listening skills.

Will I receive any recognition on completing the workbooks?

Once you have completed your Competent Communicator manual you will receive a Competent Communicator award. You can then progress to more advanced levels. You can also have notification sent to your work place which is often regarded highly by employers.

How much does it cost?

Membership fees are due in September and March for the next membership period and are \$108 for 6 months membership. These membership fees cover the costs for the meeting facilities, insurance and running costs of the club.

Your initial joining fee is pro-rated dependent on which month you join (please see table over page). Your initial joining fee also includes a \$30 charge for your two Toastmaster manuals, Competent Communicator and Competent Leader, which will be sent to you from Toastmasters International.

Membership fees may be paid by cash, cheque or direct deposit.

How will I know what to do at a meeting?

Along with the comprehensive information contained in the Toastmaster manuals you will also have access to a mentor. A mentor will explain to you what is involved in any roles you will be doing, the processes of the meeting and answer any questions you have.

Willetton Toastmasters is a very friendly club and all members will help you to feel comfortable and confident.

Do I have to come along to every meeting?

As a member you are expected to attend all meetings even if you do not have a role on the agenda. This is also the perfect opportunity to speak in table topics, fill in for someone else who may not have been able to attend and learn from observing other participants.

Of course there are times when other commitments or illness prevent you from attending meetings. We ask that you give as much notice as possible to the Vice President of Education (current contact details for the VP of Education are on every agenda) when you are unable to attend.

Are there any age restrictions?

Yes, you need to be 18 or over to join a Toastmasters club.
